



## 2024 ECIPA Rule Changes

These rule changes were discussed and voted on by the ECIPA Board of Directors at the annual meeting held on November 11, 2023.

### 2024 Class Rule Changes:

#### **11,000/12,000lb 2 Hot 2 Farm:**

- If driver exceeds 18 mph during the length of their pull:
  - Tractor will receive 15 points for DQ
  - \$150 fine for first offense.
  - \$150 fine for second offense.
  - Ban from competition for 375 days for third offense.
  - The purpose of this rule is to prevent a competitor from showboating or “building a road” for other competitors.

#### **13,000lb Farm Stock:**

- If driver exceeds 12 mph during the length of their pull:
  - Tractor will receive 15 points for DQ
  - \$150 fine for first offense.
  - \$150 fine for second offense.
  - Ban from competition for 375 days for third offense.
  - The purpose of this rule is to prevent a competitor from showboating or “building a road” for other competitors.

#### **6,200lb Super Modified 2wd Trucks:**

- There will be no changes to the 2024 rules
- Rear diameter shall not exceed 143-inch circumference when mounted on an 18-inch rim and inflated to 28 PSI. The ground patch is not to exceed 19 inches based on the original tread. (*Outlaw Rules*)

#### **6,250/6,500lb Light Limited Super Stock:**

- 30% of the scheduled 2024 season points hooks will weigh 6,500lb for both alcohol and diesel tractors.
  - The pulls will be chosen by ECIPA Tech Officials at random.
- Rear tires must have no more than 48 lugs or bars maximum.

#### **8,500lb 466 Limited Pro Stock:**

- Rear tires must have no more than 48 lugs or bars maximum.

#### **9,500lb 4.1 Limited Pro Stock:**

- No lug limit on rear tires.
- Weight Limits:
  - 4.1 Limited Pro Stocks will weigh 9,500lbs
  - Light Pro Stocks will weight 8,500lbs
  - Component Light Pro Stocks will weigh 8,300lbs.

#### **9,300lb Super Farm:**

- There will be no changes to the 2024 Rules for the 2024 Season
- Will revisit the 3.6 smoothbore turbo charger rule for the 2025 season at the 2024 ECIPA Rules Meeting.



**9,000lb Pro Farm:**

- Must follow 2024 PPL Rules.
- 9,500lbs
- 3500 RPM limit
- Will pull with the 9,500lb Hot Farm tractors

**2024 ECIPA General Rule Changes:**

- ECIPA Points will increase to 60 points for 1st place finish instead of 50 points.
  - All other points rules stay in place
- Exhaust Cross bolts:
  - 2- ½ inch grade 8 cross bolts are required for all turbocharged vehicles. These must be welded in place as close to the exhaust housing as possible. No exceptions!
  - Can use the Wimer cross in place of the 2 - ½" bolts.
- Turbo blankets are required on all open speed classes equipped with a turbocharger except for the 7,700lb 360 Hot Stock tractors.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> hitch must be covered with metal plate
- All pullers MUST sign up 1 hour prior to advertised start time of pull.
  - If you sign up late you will automatically be the third hook.
  - Late sign up will result in loss of 5 points and a \$25 late fee at sign up.
- No membership t-shirts for 2024- putting money into points fund.
