The ECIPA Board of Directors met after the ECIPA Rules Meeting to discuss and vote to approve the following rules on Saturday November 16th, 2024 at the Dubuque County Fairgrounds in Dubuque, Iowa.

Tim Vorwald will remain ECIPA President for 2025. Dan Arnold and Duke Simon will be Co-Vice Presidents during the 2025 calendar year. Co-Secretary and Treasurer's will be Emily Schemmel and Nicole Simon.

Marty Kuhlmann and Darin Hynick were voted by the members for a 3 year term to the ECIPA Board of Directors, to expire in 2028.

2025 ECIPA Class Rule Changes:

- **11,000lb/12,000lb 2 Hot 2 Farm**
 - Speed limit will remain 16 mph for 2025.
 - Speed limit DQ will be 25 points per competitor that speeds
- **13,000lb Farm Stock:**
 - Speed limit DQ will be 25 points per competitor that speeds
 - **For 2025** - All tractors MUST have a ROPS and tie-bars to compete
 - **For 2025** - Rule #6 to be removed.
 - P-Pumps are allowed for 2025. Limited to 13mm plungers
 - **For 2025** -Rule #10 to be removed.
 - Tractors to follow ECIPA hitch rules listed under ECIPA General Rules - Tractor Drawbars.
- **6,200lb Super Stock 2wd:**
 - 2025 ECIPA rules to follow Fantasy Truck Pullers rules.



- **6,250lb/6,500lb Light Limited Super Stock**
 - Weight change for 2025:
 - 6,250lb maximum weight if running 30.5x32 tires (alcohol or diesel)
 - 6,400lb maximum weight if running 24.5x32 tires for alcohol tractors only
 - 6,500lb maximum weight if running 24.5x32 tires for diesel tractors only

- **6,500lb Improved Stock:**
 - Under Engine - Rule #10 to be removed
 - Electric water pumps will be allowed.
 - For 2025 - Hand throttles will be allowed
 - Under Body & Frame - Rule #5 to change to allow racing seats with 5 point harnesses.

- **7,700lb 360 Hot Stock:**
 - ECIPA to allow ISP 7,000lb Naturally Aspirated Super Stock tractors to pull for the 2025 season
 - Only gas, open RPM, open cubic inch, naturally aspirated tractors allowed
 - Tractors must follow all ECIPA safety rules outlined in the ECIPA General Rules. Must run 18.4x38 tires.

- **8,000lb 2.6 Pro Street Diesel:**
 - Remove rule #19, #26 and #27.
 - **For 2025** - Open driveline allowed.

- **9,300lb Super Farm:**
 - Super Farm maximum weights:
 - ECIPA/ NTPA Super Farm to weigh maximum 9,400lbs
 - PPL Super Farm to weigh maximum 9,200lbs
 - Outlaw Super Farm to weight maximum 9,000lbs

- **ECIPA General Rule Changes:**
 - Under ECIPA General Rules - Clutch/Flywheel
 - **Rule #1 to read:** All competitors must sign and have on file with ECIPA a notarized Warrant of Clutch, Flywheel & Bellhousing Components form before being allowed to compete at East Central Iowa Pullers Association events during the 2025 season.
 - Form is available on the ECIPA website and **MUST** be notarized and mailed into ECIPA.
 -
 - **For 2025** - ALL competitors and staff must sign the insurance waiver at the sign up trailer and receive a wristband. Failure to do so will result in the competitor or staff from receiving any pay.
 - One Time Hook fee will increase to \$100 per hook.
 - Pulling order to change from the random number generator to all competitors drawing a chip from a bag of 500 chips to determine pulling order. Each number drawn will be removed from the chip bag for that event.



- **Tire Rule:**

- In effect for LLSS, 8500 466 Limited Pro for 2025.
 - 48 bar maximum with a tire circumference to be maximum of 212" at 5psi and 25" wide
- In effect for all other classes:
 - All 24.5x32 will have a maximum circumference of 212" at 5psi and 25" wide
 - All 30x5x32 will have a maximum circumference of 212" at 5psi and 31" wide
- **For 2026** - Tire rules will be revisited for all aftermarket pulling tires. .
